


How was the level of SPP implementation assessed?

Distribution of national/federal reports submitted for 2022 data collection (total of 67 reports received) into 5 set categories.





Overall performance across sub-indicators


Germany has a higher score in Environmental SPP Criteria compared to the global and regional median and shows good performance in Practical Support, matching the regional median and better than the global median level.
