

## SDG Goal 1 No poverty

**SDG Target 1.1** By 2030, eradicate extreme poverty for all people everywhere, currently measured as people living on less than \$1.25 a day

**SDG Indicator 1.1.1** Proportion of the population living below the international poverty line, by sex, age, employment status and geographic location (urban/rural)

**Time series** Population below the international poverty line

### 1. General information on the time series

- Date of national metadata: May 21, 2026
- National data: <https://sdg-indicators.de/1-1-1>
- Definition: The time series shows the proportion of the population living in households with income below the international poverty line (3 US dollars per person per day). The poverty line is first converted into euros using 2021 purchasing power parity (PPP) conversion factors and is subsequently adjusted to the price level of the respective survey year using the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
- Disaggregation: Not available.

### 2. Comparability with the UN metadata

- The time series is compliant with the global metadata.

### 3. Data description

- The data are sourced from the World Bank's Poverty and Inequality Platform (PIP). The PIP estimates poverty rates on the basis of household survey data, including data from the Luxembourg Income Study (LIS) Database.

Monetary poverty is measured using either household per capita income or the monetary value of household consumption per capita. For Germany, household income is used as the underlying welfare aggregate. These welfare aggregates are harmonized both across countries and over time in order to ensure the highest possible degree of comparability.

For years without available household survey data, values are interpolated or extrapolated using observations from adjacent survey years. This procedure assumes that the incomes of all individuals evolve between the survey year and the reference year in line with per capita growth rates derived from the National Accounts.
