- Definition: The time series measures the share of population who felt discriminated in their contacts with public services in the last two years. It provides information about the relative share of the population, which reported having personally felt discriminated against or harassed, as compared to the share of the total population interviewed.

• The data is based on a special evaluation from the Life Situation Survey, which is commissioned by the Federal Government and carried out by the Federal Statistical Office. In 2021 around 6,000 citizens and more than 2,700 business were interviewed.

Data is only available from 2015 onwards.
